- b) highlights the importance of the two functional areas contribution to the business's success. (20 marks)
- c) evaluates any challenges and opportunities associated with the **two** functions including any potential consequences. **(40 marks)**

Support the work with a minimum of 15 academic references and extras from other available sources in Harvard style, making sure the presentation of the report follows the correct format and professional language is utilised. **(10 marks)**
